### **Partial Transcript of Interview with Dr. Michelle Yagoda**

**Eric Michaels:** While many people consider hair loss to be a "male" issue, it commonly affects women as well. How is hair loss in women different from that in men?

**Dr. Yagoda:** Interestingly there are two major reasons, one is related to the cause of the hair loss and the other is related to the pattern of the hair loss. Almost all male hair loss is genetic or hereditary in men obviously but in women it is typically from hormonal or medical issues so the cause is different but also the pattern of the hair loss is different. Men's hair loss is typically localized to the temple, to the crown and to the proverbial bald spot on the top of the head. But in women it is a thinning of the hair throughout the scalp or even just a high hair line.

**Eric Michaels:** Roughly, how many women are affected by hair loss, thinning and/or balding?

**Dr. Yagoda:** Believe it or not more than 30,000,000 people in the United States alone are affected by hair thinning and hair loss and balding which is 15% of all women in the United States.

**Eric Michaels:** What are the common medical conditions associated with women's hair loss, thinning and balding?

**Dr. Yagoda:** Most commonly, it is related to an excessive male hormone and while this may have a genetic component it can also be related to medical problems...or even medications that someone may be taking like the birth control pill...
